WORDS OF EVERLASTING LIFE

“Heaven and earth will pass away,” Jesus assures us in today’s Gospel, “but my words will not pass away.” Foreboding words about the end of the world may distress us, but Jesus’ words bring us glory. Word-made-flesh, Jesus walked and talked among us. We have inherited his gospel. Jesus gave us the words of everlasting life so that we can look forward to his second coming with faith, hope, and love.

While we wait, the Lord accompanies us in word and sacrament. If we begin to feel anxious, Jesus is with us. We can turn to his words in the Bible and experience his closeness. If we are overwhelmed by our shortcomings and sins, we can participate in the liturgy and feel the intimacy of Jesus in the Eucharist and in one another. The world will end, certainly. But Jesus, the Word of God, has already conquered death. Jesus invites us be unafraid. Over and over again in the Gospels, Jesus says not to fear, offering instead his deep and lasting peace.

We believe this program will enhance our understanding, participation and benefit derived from our participation at Mass.

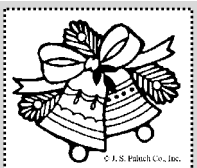
