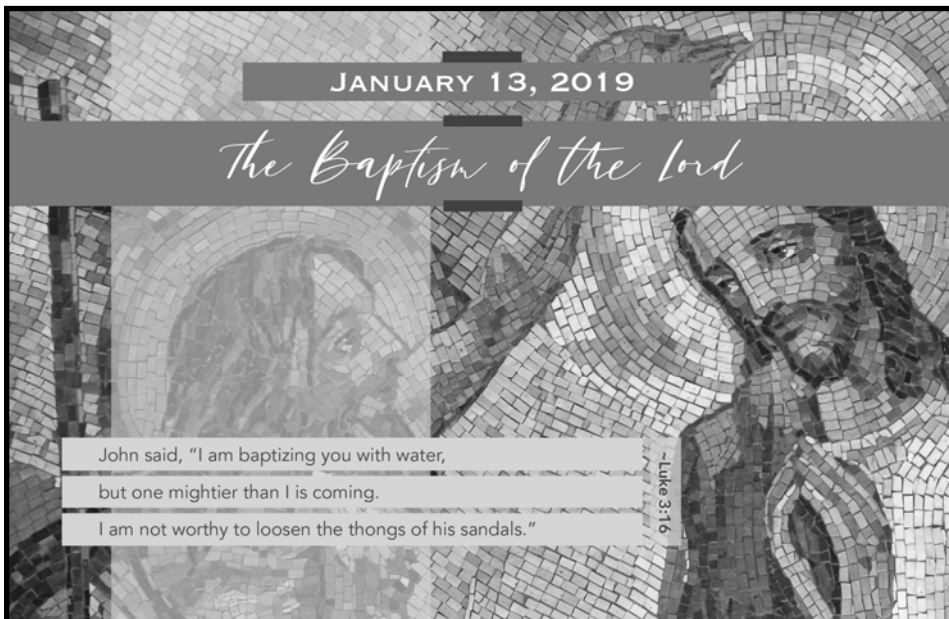

Anointing of the Sick

Baptisms

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

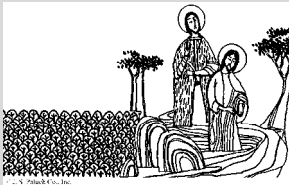
